# **ULCEROVET**

Product containing a standardized powder from the herb of Maytenus ilicifolia, which is beneficial in the treatment of stomach ulcers in horses.

Protects the stomach lining from damage by reducing gastric acid secretion and stimulating prostaglandin production. Maytenus also has an anti-inflammatory and analgesic effect.

# **EFFECTS**

- » Reduces pain symptoms in horses with stomach ulcers.
- » Anti-inflammatory and analgesic effect – protects the stomach lining by reducing hydrochloric acid production and stimulating the production of prostaglandin (production of protective mucus).
- » Reduces the amount of bacteria involved in the inflammatory response, normalizing both the stomach and gut microbiome.

## **USE**

» Treatment of gastric ulcers in horses (reduces gastric acid secretion and stimulates prostaglandin production

- » When administering painkillers or antibiotics.
- » Preventive administration in the case of stress.
- » In cases of the insufficient efficacy of proton pump inhibitors.

### **INGREDIENTS**

100% standardized Maytenus ilicifolia powder

## RECOMMENDED DOSAGE

Daily dose for horses: 3–6 g Pour hot water over the powder and mix. Administer after cooling. After three weeks of use, take a 1-week break.
